Robert Harris Archer (1820-1878), Second Lieutenant, First U.S. Regiment Voltiguers and Fort Rifleman, 1847

Wakeman Bryarly, Jr. (1820-1869), assistant surgeon, Regimental Staff, Maryland and District of Columbia Volunteers, buried in Green Mount Cemetery, Baltimore City

Edward Cain, born in Harford County, private, Co. F, 5th U.S. Artillery, Battle of Palo Alto

Bartholomew Carroll (1805-1875), buried in Mt. Erin Cemetery, Havre de Grace

Hugh B. McGaw, born in Harford County, service record undetermined, Battle of Palo Alto

Aquila Michael, private, U.S. Dragoons, Battle of Palo Alto

John O'Brien, private, recruit from Harford County, company undetermined, Battle of Palo Alto

Charles Quinlan, born in Harford County, private, Co. A, 1st U.S. Dragoons, Battle of Palo Alto

Edward B. Ricketts, born in Harford County, private, Co. G and Co. H, 6th U.S. Infantry, Battle of Palo Alto

John Rodgers III (1812-1882), Lieutenant, U.S. Navy, 1847

Edward Smith, born in Harford County, private, Co. H, 2nd U.S. Artillery,
Battle of Palo Alto

William Stifler, born in Harford County, private, Co. B, 4th U.S. Artillery,
Battle of Palo Alto

John Adams Webster (1787-1877), Capt., U.S. Navy, resided at Mt. Adams
near Creswell, buried in family cemetery at nearby "Broom's Bloom"

Henry Wright, possible sergeant under command of Capt. James J. Archer,
1847
